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Description:

This course develops increased competence in French with a focus on French customs and culture. In addition, the course provides many opportunities to listen to native French speakers and to record your own voice to help enhance your pronunciation

The course content is delivered mostly via an *online e-book* which offers a variety of interactive activities, a virtual *Grammar Tutor* that helps students grasp French grammar concepts by relating them to the same concepts in English, a virtual *Home Tutor* that allows for individual study, a virtual *Language Coach* that answers students' questions on grammar usage, a *French Reader* with authentic texts at various levels of difficulty and a *News and Networking* sections that contains many current news articles and videos. In addition a *French Vocabulary App* features audio slowdown, multiple choice quizzes and much more (compatible with iPhone, iPod touch and iPad).
