

History 12

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Description

BC History 12 is an enriched online course - There are 7 units:

1. Studying History
2. The Effects of World War I
3. The US and the Soviet Union as Developing Superpowers
4. Between the Wars
5. World War II
6. Transformation and Tension During the Cold War
7. Entering the 21st Century

It includes:

- 25 embedded online video files (from 3 to 20 minutes in length)
- 15 quizzes that the student can do for review (not for marks)
- Background music in sections matching the time periods
- Images and audio from different time periods (speeches, etc)
- 230 glossary links that link terms to definitions, pictures and video
- Discussion posts discussing the many issues of History 12 from the end of World War One to the end of the cold war
- 12 online activities constituting 60% of the marks
- A midterm and final worth 35%

Required resources:

History 12 requires a textbook - *Global Forces of the 20th Century* – 2nd or 3rd Ed.

Assessment Strategies / Performance Standards

There are 2 tests (35%) that need to be completed online, but invigilated by a teacher. There is one essay (12%) and one major assignment (9%), 10 activities (39%) and 10 discussions (5%) that need to be submitted online in the course.
